### Remembrance Sunday



Thank you to all who send in your stories of good news and community. It has been wonderful this week to hear how our circuits participated in Remembrance Sunday.

- 1) **Gamblesby Chapel**, in the **Cumbria** Mission Area, have been displaying poppies outside the chapel for a number of years. Each year more poppies are added, which now provides a stunning display that is illuminated at night during remembrance week.
- 2) **St Andrew's Methodist Church**, **Bolton** in the **Greater Manchester Plus** Mission Area used a Peace Cross in the Remembrance Service. The cross was made by a member of the church, assisted by the craft and friendship group 'Company'. It shows the current places of conflict, named by country and using the colours of their individual flags. Peace prayers from Christian Aid's resources were available to take home after the service and there was an opportunity to place a paper dove or light near the cross.
